

Eligibility

In Oregon you are eligible to take the GED tests if you:

- Are 16 years of age or older.
- Have not graduated from an accredited high school.
- Are not enrolled in high school for credit.
- Have not earned a GED certificate.

Preparation

If you are not sure you are ready to take the tests and/or need help to prepare for the tests, contact the staff at one of RCC's Learning Centers (see back). Instructors will help you determine whether you need to study for all the tests or only need to brush-up your skills in a few areas. Practice tests are also available.

It is recommended that you do your studying for the GED tests before you register to test. If you would like to study independently for the tests, there are GED study materials available in the library or for purchase in bookstores. For online practice tests: www.gedpractice.com, or www.acenet.edu, or www.Gedwriting.com.

Special Needs

Accommodations for disabilities are available. Please contact the GED examiner at the testing center for more information.

French, Spanish, large print and audio editions of the GED tests are available from the state office. These tests should be requested at the time of registration.

GED Testing Registration

Please bring the following items with you when you register for the GED tests:

➤ VALID ID

Current government-issued ID (driver's license, permit, DMV ID card, passport or military ID) is required. ID **must** show *name, picture, birth date, address and signature*.

➤ SOCIAL SECURITY CARD

The card must show your current name.

➤ RECEIPT OF PAYMENT

Payment must be made through Rogue Central Services on campus. The receipt must be presented at the registration session. The current fee for the battery of five tests is \$110. **The fees are non-refundable.**

➤ EXEMPTION or WAIVER

If you are 16 or 17 years of age, you **must** have either an "Exemption from Compulsory Attendance" or "Options Waiver" documents from a RCC Learning Center or your local high school. Home school students must present documents from the Southern Oregon Education Service District.

The above documentation is used to verify eligibility to take the GED tests. **If any of this documentation is missing, you will not be permitted to register.**



The GED Tests

Five individual tests make up the GED battery. A candidate must score a 410 or better on each test and earn an average of 450 or better on the battery to earn a certificate. The tests are in the multiple choice format with the exception of the Writing Test, which includes both multiple choice questions and a written essay.

Language Arts-Writing	120 min.
Language Arts-Reading	65 min.
Social Studies	70 min.
Science	80 min.
Math	90 min.

Testing

You must be registered with the "GED Testing Center" to take the GED tests.

Once your registration is complete, you may begin testing. You must sign-in one-half hour before each test session begins. Specific tests are given on specific dates. You will be given a detailed testing schedule at registration which outlines when the different tests are being given. Calendars are available online: www.roguecc.edu/GED/GEDtesting.asp. Seating is limited to 20 students per session.

Each time you test you **must** show your current government ID. High school students may need to bring additional paperwork to the testing session. Check with the examiner beforehand if there are questions.
