This is a group registration. Please pay your fees ahead of time. It takes approximately 3 hours to complete the registration process.

Bring the items below with you to registration.

- ❖ **\$110 Paid Receipt:** Non-refundable fee must be paid before registration.
- ❖ **Valid Photo ID:** Must be non-expired, government issued with a current address.
- ❖ **Social Security Card**
- ❖ **Exemption Form:** Ages 16-17 (and older, if enrolled in high school) must obtain this form, or an Options waiver from high school to test. Options students need an authorization letter and an information release.
- ❖ **Home Schoolers:** Those under 18 need Options waiver documents. Pick up these documents from the ESD office before attending registration.
- ❖ **GED Transfers:** If you have tested elsewhere, we must have a transcript from the last test site before you may begin testing here. It must be sent to us directly from them.

Officially Test

You must register with the Riverside Testing Center before you begin official GED testing. A valid (non-expired) government issued photo ID with a current address is required to test.
