The College's Strategic Plan for 2008-2012 is a work in progress. A strategic planning steering committee, chaired by the college president is monitoring progress of four (4) teams made up of college faculty, staff, students and community members who are working on an environmental scan/SWOT analysis, review of the college's values, mission and vision (below), and developing strategic issues and institutional goals and objectives based on stakeholders institutional mandates, trends and other related research.

Their work will be synthesized by representatives of each group, reviewed and approved by the College's Institutional Planning and Effectiveness Council, Executive Council and the steering committee. Ultimately the five-year plan will be discussed and adopted by the RCC Board.
