Teatro Milagro will perform “American Sueño” at Rogue Community College, with free shows and workshops scheduled in Grants Pass and Medford.

“American Sueño (“The American Dream”) shares the stories of four marginalized individuals searching for a better job, a better life, a better tomorrow. American Sueño is a hopeful journey in search of a new era of acceptance. The play is written and directed by Rebecca Martínez, Teatro Milagro’s artistic director.
