## **RCC** Reopens for Classes After Law Enforcement Clears Campuses

GRANTS PASS, Ore.--Law enforcement agencies have now completed clearing all Rogue Community College campuses and buildings, and they have determined there is no present threat to safety. **Classes and all other activities will resume on normal schedules tomorrow** (Tuesday) morning.
