2. Explore Values  A. Recommend 4-7 Core Values	<p>Reviewed mission recommendation before starting values exercise: <i>The mission of RCC is to ensure each learner's success. The College strives to be a powerful force for quality of life in our region.</i></p> <p>Team B agrees w/current core values: <i>Integrity, Respect and Excellence</i>, but recommends changing "Courage" to "<i>Empowerment</i>." The description re <i>Empowerment</i> should read: <i>Empowerment</i> allows us to define leadership, to take risks, to welcome change, to be responsive and to be innovative.</p> <p>Other words for "define" were "provide," "guide," "incorporate," "permeate," and "embody."</p> <p>Other core values that were worked into values statements were: innovation, fairness, dignity, responsibility/accountability, relevancy, responsiveness, supportive</p>	<p>Change the word "ensure" to "promote"/Denise S./11/28/07</p> <p>Change the sentence on <i>Respect</i> to read as follows: "Respect cultivates an environment that honors . . . ."/ Denise S./11/28/07</p>
3. Explore Vision  A. Recommend RCC embrace or revise current vision or adopt new	<p>The team reviewed their understanding of what a vision statement should be from definitions provided and decided that the current College vision is too broad and not focused.</p> <p>Some words the team initially discussed for what our collective vision should include were: <b>success and efficiency, collaboration and change/ changing world.</b> Other ideas they might like to grasp included: <b>inspiring to learn</b> (from current vision), <b>being the region's first choice for training and education, teaching/ preparing, and pooled interdependence.</b></p> <p>Common college phrases such as "our goal is your success," and "life's best lesson's start here" were determined to be slogans and not vision statements.</p>	<p>Review 11/14 notes and definitions and write at least one or more possible vision statements to be reviewed and discussed by the team at the 11/28/07 meeting/all team members/11/28/07</p> <p>Review SWOT and begin thinking about strategic issues in the form of questions related to top SWOT/all team members/11/28/07</p>
