

TECHNICAL TRAINING FUND

A scholarship for individuals who show extraordinary technical or artistic potential in areas such as craftsmanship, manual skills, art, music, culinary arts, or related areas.

Who can apply

Read the scholarship description for details

- Oregon residents
- High school graduates, including GED and home-schooled graduates, enrolled in a vocational or trade school
- Undergraduates entering their junior or senior year, or graduate studies at a traditional 4-year college
- Part-time students
- Attending a USA college (2- or 4-year college)

Scholarship Description

- Preference: Juniors, seniors or graduate-level students enrolled at a 4-year institution or students enrolled at special vocational/trade schools
- Career field: Applicants must demonstrate extraordinary technical or artistic potential in the areas of craftsmanship, manual skills, art, music, culinary arts, or other related areas
- Must enroll at least half-time
- FAFSA filing is required. Financial need may or may not be considered
- Apply-competitively annually
- Additional requirement: Briefly describe (one page maximum) your area of extraordinary technical or artistic potential in the areas of craftsmanship, manual skills, art, music, culinary arts, or related areas. Provide the name and phone number of an individual (e.g., teacher, professor, employer, advisor, counselor, mentor) who can speak to that potential
