Special Meeting: Board of Education Work Session  
June 20, 2023 Meeting Minutes***

1. **Call to Order-** The Rogue Community College (RCC) Special Board of Education (Board) meeting was called to order by Pat Fahey, Board Chair, at 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 20, 2023 in-person on the Table Rock Campus, Room A-184, 7800 Pacific Avenue, White City, OR and via Zoom. Due notice was given.
2. **Determine Presence of a Quorum-** A quorum of the Board was present including: Pat Fahey, Roger Stokes, Maria Ramos Underwood, Claudia Sullivan, and Pat Ashley.

4. **Information Presentation:**
  - A. Ossie's Cupboard, Inclusive Career Advancement Program (ICAP), SNAP Training and Employment Program (STEP), and House Bill 2835- Rene McKenzie, Director of Student Engagement, explained to the Board the student resources activity that would take place during the work session. The Board and guests were divided into two groups. They were then given clues in the form of problems that an RCC student might face and instructed to find the student resource on the Table Rock Campus (TRC) that would best solve that particular problem. As the teams worked their way around the student resources at TRC, they learned about the benefits of each resource.
