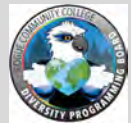

myRogue DON'Ts

Don't worry! RCC staff are available on all campuses at Rogue Central to assist you in using **myRogue!**

Don't have a degree or certificate program affiliated with your **myRogue** account? Contact your Academic & Career Coach.

Don't use the back button. It's best to click on the link or tab of the service you are browsing to.

Don't see the "Register" button? Contact your Academic & Career Coach.

Don't be afraid to ask for help if the registration feature isn't working for you...you may have a hold on your account.

Types of holds include:

Collections/Payment Holds (contact collections@rogucecc.edu)

Academic Alert I/II (contact advisingfrontdesk@rogucecc.edu)

Financial Aid Repayment (contact your Financial Aid Advisor)

Disciplinary or Academic Probation/Suspension Hold (contact counselingfrontdesk@rogucecc.edu)

Don't expect to manage your financial aid or account balances on myRogue. The data displayed is only for your information. You will be taken to either MyFinAid or Transact (RCC's payment portal) to perform financial activities toward your account.

Don't forget to pay attention to alerts that show when adding to cart. They might be saying you are adding too many things (credit overload!), or the course has a co- or prerequisite or there are extra meeting times. Other alerts might be comprised of colors and icons displayed on the right side of the page.

Important Takeaways for Students

1. Stay in good standing with your academics and financial aid:

RCC wants you to be successful! There are two important policies you should be aware of to stay in “good standing” that will allow you to continue to register for classes every term and access your financial aid. One policy is for academics and one policy is for financial aid.

Academic Good Standing — evaluated each term:

- A 2.0 grade point average (GPA) each term.
- Completion of at least two-thirds or 66.67% of term attempted credits (pace) with grades of A, B, C, D, or P.
- Failure to stay in good standing will result in Academic Alerts and/or Academic Suspension, which may impact your ability to register for classes.

Financial Aid Good Standing — evaluated by reviewing total/cumulative credits:

- A cumulative 2.0 grade point average (GPA - this is your overall GPA).
- Completion of at least two-thirds or 66.67% of total attempted credits (pace) with grades of A, B, C, D, or P.
- Failure to stay in good standing will result in Financial Aid Alerts and/or Financial Aid Suspension, which may impact your ability to continue to receive financial aid.



Important Takeaways for Students

2. Register early:

Don't delay; courses fill up quickly. Register early to ensure your spot.

View the schedule to see when registration begins for the upcoming

term. Registered students also get priority financial aid processing.

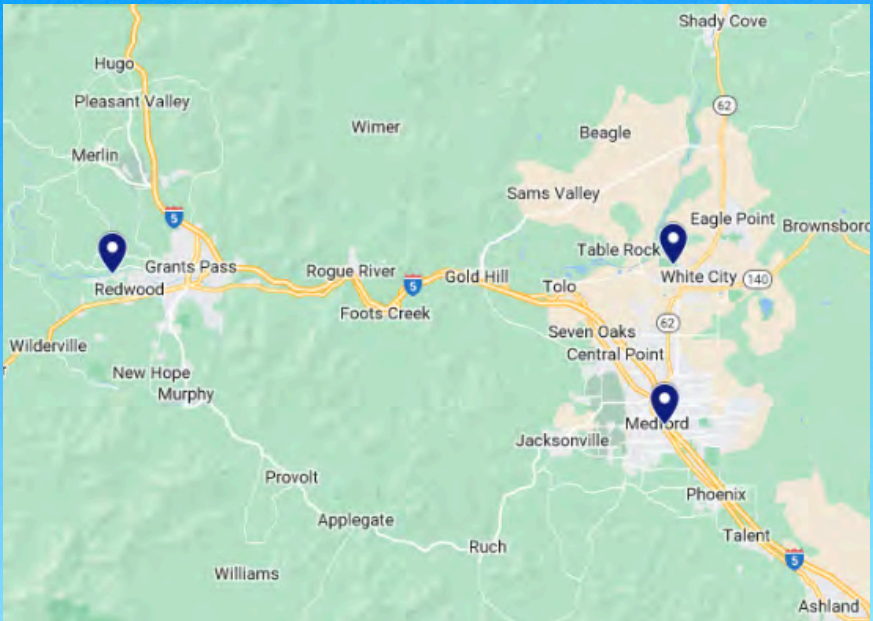
