RCC Women's Soccer Preps for Inaugural Season

GRANTS PASS/MEDFORD, Ore.--The Ospreys Women's Soccer team is flying right into the next chapter for this budding program. With training camp a month away, and opening day on Sept. 12, Head Coach Rusty Veth is putting the final touches on what will become the inaugural roster for Rogue Community College Women's Soccer.

"I'm excited to see all the players together next month. I think we have put together a strong roster so far," says Coach Veth, adding that he is still looking for a few more players to fill out the roster; they are sitting at 15 right now with 3 more in the works. "I'm happy with the caliber and character of the players who have committed so far, and see that we have great building blocks for the foundation of the program."

Veth vowed to search high and low for players to begin the season and has so far found players from Grants Pass, Medford, Shady Cove, Eagle Point, Trail, and Ashland.

"I wanted to make sure to provide opportunities to the players in the local area first and foremost," Veth says, "and as the recruiting process has gone on I've widened my search, but really I've found a lot of high quality players here. I don't need to search too far."

The Women's Soccer team starts its training camp August 10, and five days later the team will head up to Klamath Falls to scrimmage Oregon Tech (OIT). Between the scrimmage with OIT and the first regular season game on September 12 against Portland Community College--another first year soccer program in the NWAC conference--the Ospreys will head to Eugene to play in the NWAC Friendlies Tournament on August 29 and 30 where they will tangle with Yakima Valley and Wenatchee Valley respectively.
