MEDFORD, Ore.—Rogue Community College’s (RCC), Individualized Career Training Department (ICT) is hosting a free information session.

Anyone interested in learning new career skills through individualized, on-the-job training also known as Occupational Skills Training (OST) is welcome to attend this session on Fri., Oct. 9, 2 to 3 p.m., Riverside Campus in Medford, Building G, Room 5 (117 S. Central Ave).

ICT/OST offers a wide variety of career opportunities not found elsewhere at RCC. New training options are added on a regular basis and staff may be able to custom-design a training program related to individual student’s specific interests. OST is a state-approved, one-year certificate program. It uses the community as the classroom for hands-on learning in a variety of career fields chosen to extend offerings while not overlapping with other RCC programs.

To apply for the program, candidates must first attend one of these free monthly information sessions. The sessions are only one hour and open to all current and potential students. The information provided is designed to help students determine whether OST is the right educational path for them.
