## Ospreys Men Down PCC, Get in Win Column, Women Tie

GRANTS PASS/MEDFORD, Ore.--The RCC Ospreys men's and women's soccer teams walked away with heads held high from the men's victory and women's tie against Portland Community College in the Northwest Athletic Conference (NWAC) play on Saturday, October 17.

The Ospreys men's team dominated PCC, scoring 4 goals and giving up only 1 in the match. Ospreys Ivan Enciso scored 2, and Allan Ramos-Garcia and Jose Lopez each scored 1, leading to the team's first victory of their first season. The Ospreys keeper Hector Rocha had 4 saves in the match.

"We finally were rewarded for the hard work in our first half," Coach Greg Millick commented. "We have been training overtime and the work has paid off for us today. I am proud of the players for all of their hard work and dedication on the field today." The men's team is now 1-8 in the NWAC.

The Osprey women's team tied PCC 0-0 in a match marked by extra hustle.

"The effort and teamwork that they put in made so proud to be associated with the character of this team," Coach Rusty Veth said of the match. Keeper Ashley Green had 5 saves during the match, keeping the score knotted for the 0-0 tie. The women's team is now 0-7-1 in the NWAC.

The Ospreys' next match will take place this Wednesday, October 21. The men and women go against Clark at US Cellular Fields, Medford Oregon.
