

FAFSA on Hold Pending DHS Match

Your eligibility for Federal Student Aid as a noncitizen is under review by the Department of Homeland Security (DHS). DHS will continue to check its records and notify RCC once more information is available.

If you can provide one of the following documents, we may be able to begin reviewing your FAFSA sooner:

- A Permanent Resident Card (I-551)
- A Conditional Green Card (I-551C)
- An Arrival-Departure Record (I-94) from the Department of Homeland Security showing any one of the following designations: "Refugee," "Asylum Granted," "Parolee" (I-94 confirms that you were paroled for a minimum of one year and status has not expired), T-Visa holder (T-1, T-2, T-3, etc.) or "Cuban-Haitian Entrant"
- A valid certification or eligibility letter from the Department of Health and Human Services showing a designation of "Victim of human trafficking."

If you have one of these items (or have questions), send a copy via email to your [assigned FinAid Advisor](#) per your pathway or bring it in person to an [FinAid Advising Office](#) on campus.

If you do NOT have one of these items, we are required to wait for an update from DHS.
