You said on the FAFSA you are a U.S. citizen or eligible noncitizen. The federal government could not confirm this information. If the document confirms your status, we can continue processing your FAFSA.

- Certificate of Naturalization (N-550 or N-570), Certificate of Citizenship (N-560 or N-561).**
- Student's birth certificate** – showing that the student was born in the United States, a U.S. Territory, or one of the Freely Associated States. Birth certificates showing a student was born abroad (not a U.S. jurisdiction) are not acceptable.
- U.S. Passport/ wallet-sized passport** – Other than 'Limited" passports, and 'Noncitizen National' passports. Passport may be current or expired. Passport cards are acceptable documentation, but one-year duration passports are not acceptable.
- Form FS-240 (Consular Report of Birth Abroad), FS545 (Certificate of Birth Issued by a Foreign Service Post), or DS1350 (Certification of Report of Birth)** – These are State Department documents.
- Special Proof of Citizenship Circumstances** – there are other statuses that qualify which may be documented. We encourage you to check these statuses at the [CCAC Help Center](#).
- Eligible Noncitizen** - If you are an eligible noncitizen, make sure your 26/27 FAFSA shows that status and includes your correct Alien Registration Number (ARN). If you entered the wrong information on the FAFSA, you or your school must submit a correction with the correct eligible noncitizen details. The correction usually takes about three business days to process, getting verified with the Department of Homeland Security. Provide a copy of your **Permanent resident/alien card (I-551)** issued by U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services.
- Other** – My legal citizenship or non-citizen status is not listed above. I have attached a statement and the required document(s) to show my eligible aid status.

**Student Certification:** *I confirm the documents I provided are real and show my correct status. I understand if I knowingly provide fake, incomplete, or misleading information, I may face criminal penalties.*
