

Admission Complete

If you received a request from Financial Aid for an “Admissions Complete” document, you’re not showing as “Admitted” to RCC yet or weren’t at the time your FAFSA was received.

1. **If you have completed high school (or the equivalent) regardless of your current age:**
 - Log in to your [myRogue account](#) and update your “High School Completion Level.” To do so, go to the “Records” section and click “Personal Information.”
 - Notify your [FinAid Advisor](#) when this is complete.

2. **If you are 18 or older but haven’t finished high school (or the equivalent) yet:**
 - [Contact your FinAid Advisor](#) and ask them to manually admit you since you are 18+ years of age.
 - Once they have done so they can mark that off your “to do” list and discuss your FinAid options if you haven’t completed high school or the equivalent.

3. **If you are 17 or younger and haven’t finished high school (or the equivalent) yet:**
 - If you’re completing before or during the school year for which you’ve applied for aid (FAFSA or ORSAA), no action is needed at this time.
 - Please update your “High School Completion Level” once you have completed, which will admit you.
 - Notify your [FinAid Advisor](#) when this is complete.
 - If you will not be completing high school or the equivalent during the school year for which you’ve applied for aid, you will not be eligible for federal or state aid that school year.
 - Please [contact your FinAid Advisor](#) to discuss funding options.
