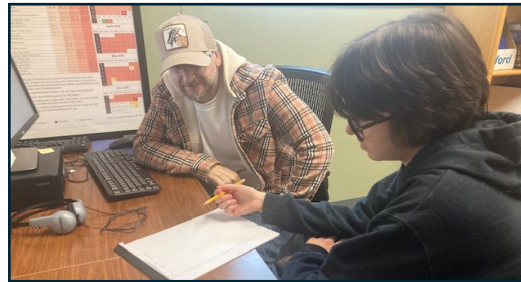


Redwood Hike & Beach Cleanup

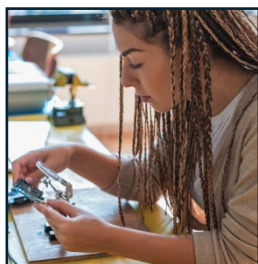
RCC Foundation Scholarships
