(1) These locations have not been reported in RCC's past annual reports because of a misunderstanding. They are being added this year forward until there is a change or changes. Locations have been listed even if they do not meet the criteria of 50% of degree credit at the location on Vice President Goad's recommendation. Clarification regarding listing of these sites was established in a June 4, 2015 telephone conference with Vice President Goad wherein she indicated this information is helpful in determining appropriate site visit location in the future and to assist the Commission with tracking of necessary Title IV information. These are historical sites that have been communicated through correspondence, and/or major substantive change reports and/or in self-study reports to the Commission for the past 40 years whenever they became applicable.

(2) S3 (new degrees/certificates) and S4 (termination of degrees/certificates): It was also established in June 4, 2015 conversation with VP Goad that new and terminated degrees or certificates should be handled by Substantive Change Application Form and reported in the future as soon as the College's Board of Education approves the new or terminated degrees/certificate. This year the six new degrees/certificates and 1 terminated degree certificate are forthcoming in one report but it is understood that these reports must and will be submitted on a case-by-case basis in the future.
