

Dental x-rays anyone?



Do you or someone you know need dental x-rays? During the winter term, students in RCC's Dental Assistant program have a radiology lab requiring the students to take full mouth sets of x-rays as practice and for their clinical examinations. We are looking for patients who qualify.

Qualifying patients:

- **must have at least 24 fully erupted teeth (visible and present in the mouth)**
- **be at least 18 years old**
- **be eligible for a full-mouth x-ray:** this usually means that you have NOT had a full mouth x-ray within the last 3 years. **(18 individual films)**

A full-mouth set of x-rays can cost a patient ~\$250.00 in a dental office. You will be helping a student and for that, they will take the x-rays at no charge. At your request, x-rays can be sent to your dental office.
