Minimum Qualifications:

1. **Age:** Must be at least 18 years old (nonreturnable proof required).
2. **Education:** Must provide proof of high school graduation or GED completion (nonreturnable).
3. **Math Competency:** Must have completed at least one year of high school algebra or equivalent post-secondary algebra course with a grade of "C" or better, or demonstrate proficiency through community college placement testing or WorkKeys Assessments (Applied Mathematics, Reading for Information, Locating Information) with an Oregon Career Readiness Certificate at Silver level or higher.

All required documentation demonstrating that minimum qualifications are met must be submitted online.

Applications that do not meet the minimum qualifications, or whose documentation does not fulfill the required criteria, will not be considered for an interview. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure all materials are complete and meet all stated requirements prior to submission.

Selection Process and Method

The selection process uses a **random lottery of qualified applicants** to establish a pool of eligibles for the apprenticeship program. Individuals selected through this process will be notified of their ranking and provided with information regarding the apprenticeship, related training, and formal indenturing.

Geographical Area: Jackson, Josephine, Klamath, and Lake Counties, Oregon

Selection Method Details:

- Applicants must meet all minimum qualifications to be eligible.
- Selection is based on a lottery system. Applicants are notified of their ranking and referred to employers requesting apprentices in descending order from the pool.
- Applicants who fail to respond or accept employment after multiple contacts may be removed from the list.
- Only one application per enrollment period is allowed.
- **Employment Requirement:** Applicants not already affiliated with a training agent must secure employment with a training agent by **September 1, 2026**, or they will be removed from the pool of eligible applicants.
