Cameras in RCC Vehicles

In an effort to meet national standards of best practice for safe learning environments, RCC, like many other approved Driver Education Training institutions, has placed video cameras inside all vehicles used for transportation training. The cameras record the student driver, their activity, and the instructor in the passenger seat. The cameras are professionally installed. The data from the cameras is handled only by RCC personnel and is not made available to any other entity without proper channels through the institution's legal system.

Medical Statement

For instructor and student safety, please advise our staff if you have any medical condition, limitation, or are taking any medication that may affect the safe operation of a motor vehicle. This includes any seizure disorder, vision impairment, learning disabilities, diabetes, etc. If a student shows signs of being impaired for any reason (lack of sleep, drugs, alcohol, prescription medication), they will not be allowed to get behind the wheel of the Driver Education vehicle.

Behind the Wheel Lesson Plan

Lesson structure is at the instructor's discretion. Instructors will create a lesson plan and drive route based on an assessment of the student's skill level with consideration of the student's overall goal for the lesson.

Behind-the-Wheel Expectations

Students must bring a valid driving permit or license to all behind-the-wheel sessions. Students must wear appropriate clothing and shoes to their lesson. No sandals, flip-flops, or heals are allowed in the car. Extremely long fingernails that prevent a student from firmly gipping the steering wheel are not allowed. We suggest students wear comfortable, securely fitted shoes. Appropriate corrective lenses are required, and sunglasses are highly recommended. Please review your calendar to ensure there are no conflicts with drive times. If a student has a conflict with the arranged drive time, the student must contact the behind the wheel instructor no later than 24 hours before the drive. **If a student does not show up for a scheduled lesson, they will be charged a no-show fee of \$50.** Please be on time to your appointment. **DRIVER EDUCATION VEHICLES WILL NOT WAIT MORE THAN 5 MINUTES PAST THE APPOINTED TIME.**
