

## RCC Associate Degree Dental Hygiene Program Prerequisite/Course Completion Chart

This form serves as a double-check to make sure you have met at least the minimum eligibility: **44-46 graded credits of the required prerequisite coursework**, including **MTH65** or higher and **BI231** with a cumulative prerequisite GPA of at least 2.5 completed by the **fall term**. For the calculation of your application GPA, your most recent grade in a course will be used. By the end of the summer term 2026, **total prerequisite and elective courses should equal 44-46 or more credits**.

**Exception:** If you have completed more than one math course that would equally apply to a requirement, the course with a higher grade will be used. If you are admitted to the program, all prerequisite courses (minimum of 44-46 credits) must be completed with a "C" or better (C- grades not accepted) by the end of the summer term to retain acceptance. (**NOTE:** BI 234 is available fall, winter, and spring terms at RCC but not summer term.)
