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## Driver Education Program (ages 15-21)

The Rogue Community College Driver Education Program provides teens with the opportunity to acquire the needed skills to be safe, competent drivers throughout their lives. We are committed to excellence both in the classroom and behind-the-wheel. Our ODOT approved traffic safety course consists of 30 hours of classroom instruction and 12 hours in the car (6 hours behind-the-wheel and 6 hours of observation). In-car instruction is scheduled between the student and the instructor, and occurs outside of the regularly scheduled class time. Students must have a permit to create an account and register for class.

### What are the benefits of taking this program?

- Students who complete the program receive a Certificate to waive their drive test at the DMV when getting their license!
- Many insurance agencies offer discounts for students who have successfully completed this program
- Successful students gain improved driving skills that lead to lower crash and citation rates
- Reduces DMV required supervised training down to just 50 hours!

# **RCC FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS APPLICATION OPENS FEBRUARY 1ST!**

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## What is the RCC Foundation?

The RCC Foundation awards approximately \$500,000 annually.

Our goal is to award \$1,000-\$6,000 per recipient. We are generally able to award about 1 in 3-4 applicants. Be sure to put care into your application.

There are over 13,000 vetted, external scholarships in ScholarshipUniverse; real funding to help real students...like YOU.

## Who Can Apply?

Anyone with RCC login credentials who has a GPA (grade point average) of at least 2.5 and will enroll in at least 6 credits at RCC 2022 Fall (and following).

We recommend that you submit a Federal Student Aid or ORSAA application to be considered for need-based scholarships.

## What Happens Next?

2022/23 award offers will be sent to RCC student emails starting in July, including scholarship name, amount, and criteria to maintain eligibility.

You must submit a timely on-line thank you to accept each offer. Scholarships are added to your Financial Aid Award Letter, then applied to your RCC student account generally just prior to each Fall/Winter/Spring term. Any excess balance is refunded to you to be used toward the cost of living.
