Program Highlight: Medical Assistant

A medical assistant assists doctors in the performance of patient care, examination, and documentation. Medical Assistants perform or assist in taking vitals, front office medical administrative tasks, back office clinical procedures and ECG testing. Medical assistants are the face of medical offices and often the first people with whom patients come into contact.

They may perform basic medical coding and billing, scheduling, and patient flow and triage. Other duties may include waive testing, phlebotomy and specimen collection. Medical assistants are responsible for recording patient information into the electronic medical records systems and must be able to master several types of computer software programs. Quality improvement, safety, procedural accuracy, and knowledge of regulatory practice standards are defining aspects of this practitioner's role.

Medical Assisting is a rewarding career that offers both flexibility and stability. This job is in high demand, with the projected growth reaching 29% by 2022.

College Now registration is coming!

Teachers have received information for student registration. Registration for College Now is Nov 15 – Dec 17, with limited allowances until Jan 7.

The withdraw period is extremely short because of the high school semester, it will be from Jan 12 – Jan 14.

Grades are due Jan 24, or Jan 30, depending on when the class ends.

Don't forget to have students complete the RCC Admissions process if they do not already have an RCC ID# (if they've taken a College Now class or a driver training class at RCC they already have an ID# and should not reapply). Please email recruitment@rogucecc.edu to get student ID#'s if needed.

ScholarshipUniverse

The Rogue Community College Foundation is a non-profit organization founded in 1980 to serve the needs of Rogue Community College and RCC students. The RCC Foundation expands access to education and helps to create opportunity for students through scholarships and program support. The RCC Foundation awards approximately \$500,000 annually. Our goal is to award \$1,000-\$6,000 per recipient. We are generally able to award about 1 in 3-4 applicants. There are over 13,000 vetted, external scholarships in ScholarshipUniverse; real funding to help real students...**like YOU.**

Who

Anyone with RCC login credentials who has a GPA (grade point average) of at least 2.5 and will enroll in at least 6 credits at RCC 2022 Fall (and following).

We recommend that you submit a timely FAFSA® Application | Federal Student Aid(link is external) or ORSAA(link is external) application to be considered for need-based scholarships.

When

Internal (from the RCC Foundation): Opens February 1, 2022 and closes June 1, 2022. Submit a complete application by April 1, 2022 to be entered into a bonus \$500 Early Bird drawing.

External: Year-round. See individual scholarships for application deadlines.

How

Log into ScholarshipUniverse using your RCC credentials:

- You were assigned an RCC ID, email and password when you applied for admission.
- Click the link for FAQ concerning access.
- Apply for internal and external scholarships.
- Answer questions to be matched to scholarships that you qualify for.
- Watch for RCC student emails and texts. Return to your ScholarshipUniverse Dashboard anytime to monitor your status and keep applying.
