- Ms. Stanton welcomed everyone and began the Budget Advisory Team (BAT) Forum at 9:00 a.m.
- Budget Updates: Ms. Stanton discussed the items below
 - o An overview of RCC's budget timeline and approval process.
 - The Budget website has been updated with some of the standard information. Any documents shown in blue are updated and ready to review. Items that show in grey will be updated as they're available.
 - Budget projections from May 2021 are still accurate. We're still waiting for updated information related to property taxes, state funding, and winter term enrollment.
- Program and Services Prioritization
 - New information has been posted to the website. The timeline has been updated with minor changes.
 - The Planning Documents for each division are posted. Everyone is encouraged to review them.
 - There is a box on the right of the webpage to submit questions or comments. Logging into the intranet is required. The system does not track who is making comments; you must include your name in your comment if you would like to be identified. You have the ability to review all submitted comments.

• ERP Process

• An overview of the current status of the ERP project and progress with our consultants was discussed. The website will be updated as more information is available.

• We will request ERP vendors provide two presentions; one for everyone in a summary form with a high-level overview of the student and faculty portals; the other will be an in-depth, technical presentation of all modules for the SMEs (Subject Matter Experts).

• Questions, Ideas, and Comments

Question: Why does the college want to use an ERP, and what is the purpose?

Answer: An ERP is a software system that allows us to do everything from registering a student to paying our bills. Our current ERP, RogueNet, was implemented from 1995 to 1997; it's ready for retirement.

Question: Do you think we'll have a lot more updates at the next meeting?

Answer: The next budget forum is on January 20. Additional information will be available at the next meeting, including draft documents on the prioritization and additional budget information.
