1. Welcome and Overview (Lisa Stanton)

The 2022/23 budget process is just starting. Assumptions have not been updated since the 2021/22 adopted budget. Discussed the General Fund Projections 5-14-2021 document available on the webpage (<https://web.roguecc.edu/budget-and-financial-services/202122-budget-development>).

During the annual budget development, the college considers and attempts to balance two years into the future. The first year must balance, with the second year's shortfall not exceeding \$1MM to \$1.5 MM.

This projection indicates the college is facing an \$11 million shortfall in 2023/24. The two main reasons for the excessive shortfall include a reduction in tuition and fee revenue due to lower enrollment and a significant amount of non-recurring (one-time money) included in the projection.

Discussed the current financial position of the college. Discussed the October Financial Statement available on the webpage (<https://web.roguecc.edu/budget-and-financial-services/current-year-financial-reports>).

Money from property taxes is holding steady. The amount from the Community College Support Fund RCC receives is dependent on how we perform (increase/decrease in FTE) when compared with the other 16 Oregon Community Colleges. The ending fund balance is higher than expected for 2021/22; this is to the large amount of open positions. More information is available in the executive summary.
