Rogue Community College has signed and returned a certification and agreement to the Department of Education with the assurance that the institution intends to use no less than 50% of the funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide emergency financial aid grants to students.

- 1. Rogue Community College has received a total of \$1,261,641 from the Department of Education pursuant to the institution's submitted certification and agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.
- 2. The total amount of emergency financial aid grants directly distributed to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act as of **March 31, 2021** is \$1,275,357. NOTE: This figure is more than original award and will decrease as students decline the award.
- 3. The estimated total number of RCC students who are eligible to participate in programs under Section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965 and thus eligible to receive emergency financial aid grants to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act is currently calculated at 3,672 as of 3/31/2021.
- 4. The total number of RCC students who have received an emergency financial aid grant to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act is **3,672** as of **3/31/2021**.
