Student Support Funding

Any students who are in two categories shall receive a 20% bonus, students in three categories shall receive a 30% bonus, and students in all four categories shall receive a 40% bonus.

Student support funding shall be distributed on the basis of the relative **weighted total headcount** of students from the following categories as defined in OAR 589-002-110:

- Low-income students
- ii. Adult learners
- iii. Students from Underrepresented Racial/Ethnic groups
- iv. CTE/Workforce students

Definitions of Populations

Underrepresented Racial/Ethnic groups

- Asian American/Asian
- Black/African American
- Latino/a/x/Hispanic
- Native American/Alaska Native
- Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander
- Multi-racial

Adult Learners

Students who are age 25 or older on July 1 of the academic year.

Low-income

Students who receive a federal Pell Grant or an Oregon Opportunity Grant in the academic year.

CTE and Workforce Training

Students whose coursework during the academic year contained a majority of CTE (with values 210, 211, 220, 230) or adult continuing education—workforce (with value 363).

Student Success Funding

The total number of completions in a given academic year, with each student limited to a single completion in a given academic year weighted at 100%. Completions by students from the prioritized populations defined in OAR 589-002-110 shall receive a 50% bonus, meaning they are weighted at 150%.

Student success funding shall be distributed on the basis of relative weighted total progression and completion metrics as defined below, or in OAR 589-002-110:

The number of students who, for the first time:

- Earned at least 15, but less than 30, credits weighted at 10%.
- ii. Earned at least 30 or more credits weighted at 10%.
- iii. Have at least earned credit for and completed a gateway course in a given academic year weighted at 10%.
 Only one gateway course shall count per student in a given academic year.
- iv. Met the defined contact hour thresholds for noncredit courses as defined in OAR 589-002-110 weighted at 10%.

Definitions of Populations

15+ Hours

- Earned at least 15 but fewer than 30 credits by the end of the academic year.
- Not all credits must be earned in the same year.
- All colleges contributing will receive credit.

30+ Hours

- Earned 30 or more credits by the end of the academic year.
- Not all credits must be earned in the same year.
- All colleges contributing will receive credit.

Gateway Course

- First credit in a college-level English, writing, or math course during the given academic year.
- Students are only counted once for this measure.
- College-level English, writing, or math courses at the 100 level or above with the following prefixes: ENG, ENL, WR, WRI, RDWR, MATH, and MTH

Completions

- Credential earned in an academic year (only one counts if multiple earned).
- Weighted across the previous three years.
- Includes all HECC-approved degrees, CTE certificates, non-credit training certificates, Career Pathways certificates, and the recently approved Core Transfer Map completion, when available.
