## **RCC Receives Evaluator's Report**

On April 21, 2008, Dr. William Bonaudi, President, Big Bend Community College, an evaluator for the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities (NWCCU) was on site to review RCC's progress on Recommendations 1 (strategic planning), 2 (assessment) and 3 (faculty evaluations), resulting from the College's Fall 2006 Interim Report and visit. In Fall 2008, RCC will prepare a Progress Report in response to Recommendations 4 (governance), 5 (financial plans) and 6 (master facilities plans) from the same Fall 2006 Interim Report.

In May, RCC received Dr. Bonaudi's Focused Interim Report wherein he commended the college "for its efforts to engage a large and representative sample of the college and its communities in its strategic planning process." And, "for developing a strong and effective process for evaluation of full-time faculty." He noted, "both faculty and administrators are strongly committed to its several components and its utility."

Recommendations include (1) complet[ing] the "Strategic Plan with the development and implementation of measurable outcomes, processes to collect data on achievement of the outcomes and demonstration of databased decisions effecting teaching, learning and resource allocation so it can demonstrate compliance with Standard 1.B Planning and Effectiveness." (2) "continu[ing] to support an environment of regular and continuous assessment at

all levels of the College, including instruction. Most specifically it needs to incorporate a process at all levels of assessment that documents the regular use of data to make decisions. Standard 1.B *Planning and Effectiveness* and 2.B *Educational Program Planning and Assessment.*"

And, (3) "establish[ing] a college-wide process of evaluation of part-time faculty that supplements the effective Student Evaluation of Instruction (SEI) form currently used, with other regular inputs regarding the performance of part-time faculty. Standard 4.A.5, Policy 4.1 Faculty Evaluation."

## **Institutional Priority Projects 2007/08**

All staff received copies of the final report on RCC's five institutional priority projects for 2007/08 in their spring inservice packets. Projects included, (1) building the strategic plan; (2) strengthening teaching and learning assessment, evaluation and access, (3) implementing and enhancing

workforce development and career pathways,
(4) strengthening the RCC/SOU partnership and
(5) developing an institutional facilities master plan and updating the fiscal/finance master plan. Work on these priorities is ongoing. At least three of these projects require further attention for upcoming reports and reviews from the

Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities. The other two have been folded into the new 2008-12 Strategic Plan.
